Principal's Message

Greetings Walter Reed families!

We are excited to welcome all of our students back to school this Tuesday, August 15th and look forward to a year of learning and enrichment activities. At Walter Reed we believe that learning extends beyond the classroom and that every member of the school community contributes to our culture of excellence and acceptance. Together we will make the 2017-18 school year the best yet!

Tuesday is the first day of school and the gates will open at 7:15 am. Student lists will be posted at each entrance with their Period 1 room numbers. Students will receive their class schedule in their Period 1 class. The bell rings at 7:50 for students to enter campus and go to their Period 1 class.

Every Tuesday school dismisses at 1:32 and all other school days dismissal is at 3:02. The campus is cleared every day 20 minutes after dismissal and any students still on campus must sign into a supervised after-school program to ensure safety. Students are not allowed to leave and return to campus. After 3:30 PM, students are to be picked up at the Colfax gate. Please note that the LAUSD Youth Services program will start the first day of school for new and returning students, which also provides an after-school snack free of charge.

The safety of our students is a priority. Students must use the crosswalk at all times when crossing the street at drop-off and pick-up. Please do not cross Sarah Street in the middle of the street as this is very dangerous with busy traffic. We also remind you not to block our neighborhood driveways or make U-turns. Drivers will be ticketed for traffic violations by LAPD or school police. You may designate a drop-off and pick-up location one block from campus to avoid the campus traffic.

Finally, students will be bringing home some important documents the first day of school, some to be filled out and returned. It is important that we receive these forms as soon as possible to update our data system with your contact information.

- Tires, auto, and Plastic containers and food waste
