professional athlete, etc or your favorite College/University attire. MUST BE SCHOOL APPROPRIATE!!!!

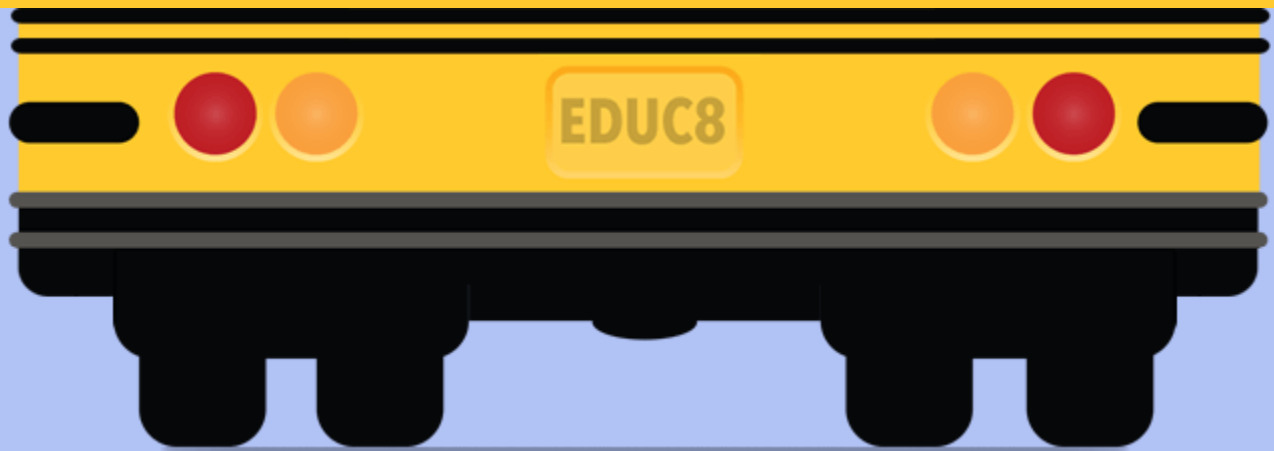
