If you do not receive the Reed Network News already, our weekly online communicator, please register by going to reedms.com. You will receive important information and updates on school events and activities, including the Reed After School Enrichment workshops and Academy web links.

Our after school policy requires that all students who are on campus 20 minutes after dismissal must wait in the pavilion area for their pick up via the Colfax gate. This includes students who participate in any after school clubs, rehearsals, or activities.

Students should sign in to the Beyond the Bell after school program by 3:30 if they have not been picked up. We do not allow students to wait in front of the school or around the perimeter of the campus to wait for their ride, as we have no ability to provide supervision in these areas. You may either call/text your child when you arrive, or park and walk through the Colfax gate to pick up your child. Your child's safety is our priority and we value your support in this policy.


