Greetings Walter Reed Families!

Walter Reed is partnering with LADOT, the Los Angeles Department of Transportation, to enforce safe passage for our children and traffic safety for our drivers. A task force will be handing out flyers to remind drivers of the importance of following safety rules, and drivers will be ticketed by LAPD or School Police. We continue to witness unsafe driving and pedestrian practices during drop-off and pick-up, such as making U-turns, students running out into the middle of the street with oncoming traffic, and double parking on Irvine, Sarah and Colfax. These are just a few of the alarming calls and emails I receive on a weekly basis from our concerned community of parents, teachers and residents.

Our children's safety is our number one priority, and we can only ensure that an accident is avoided if *everyone* makes a commitment to making safe drop-offs and pick-ups. Families have found that dropping off and picking up their child one – two blocks away from campus, or, parking off campus and walking your child to the corner cross-walk, are easy ways to avoid traffic and see your child to school safely. We are all in this together and we expect every adult to pledge a commitment to speaking to their child about safe passage and safe driving.

Un grupo de trabajo distribuirá folletos para recordar a los conductores la importancia de seguir las normas de seguridad, los conductores recibirán multas de LAPD o la Policía Escolar. Continuamos siendo testigos de prácticas de conducción y peatones inseguras durante la llegada y salida, como hacer giros en U, los estudiantes se quedan en el medio de la calle con el tráfico en sentido contrario, y el estacionamiento doble en Irvine, Sarah y Colfax. Estas son solo algunas de las llamadas y correos electrónicos alarmantes que recibo semanalmente de nuestra comunidad interesada de padres, maestros y residentes. La seguridad de nuestros niños es nuestra prioridad número uno, y solo podemos garantizar que se evite un accidente si todos se comprometen a realizar entregas y recogidas sin riesgos. Las familias han descubierto que dejar y recoger a su hijo a una o dos cuadras de la escuela, o estacionarse fuera del campo escolar y llevar a su hijo al cruce de la esquina, son maneras fáciles de evitar el tráfico y llevar a su hijo a la escuela de manera segura. Todos estamos en esto juntos y esperamos que todos los adultos se comprometan a hablar con sus hijos sobre el paso seguro y la conducción segura.




The PSAT 8/9 helps students determine what they need to work on most so that they're ready for college when they graduate from high school—and it supports educators as they guide the way.

The PSAT 8/9 tests the same skills and knowledge as the SAT, PSAT/NMSQT, and PSAT 10—in a way that makes sense for eighth and ninth graders. It measures what they're already learning, shows them whether they're on track for college, and lets them know where they need the most improvement. That means students have time to tackle these areas long before they take the SAT.


