- CHECK YOUR <u>ATTITUDE</u>—A NEGATIVE ATTITUDE WILL ONLY BRING NEGATIVE CONSEQUENCES— YOU ARE IN CHARGE OF YOUR ATTITUDE!

PARENT TIPS

- CHECK AGENDA **DAILY!**
- MONITOR COMPLETION OF HOMEWORK
- SCHEDULE TEACHER CONFERENCES AS SOON AS THERE IS A CONCERN/QUESTION ABOUT GRADES, HOMEWORK OR BEHAVIOR
- HELP YOUR SON/DAUGHTER GET ORGANIZED
- IF SON/DAUGHTER IS STRUGGLING WITH CLASS/HOMEWORK, THEY SHOULD ATTEND TUTORING IN THE LIBRARY AFTER SCHOOL (IF AVAILABLE)
- HOLD YOUR SON/DAUGHTER TO HIGH EXPECTATIONS BUT BE REALISTIC
- MAKE SURE YOU UNDERSTAND THE GRADING POLICY OF EACH TEACHER
- ENCOURAGE/INSIST YOUR SON/DAUGHTER TAKE ON PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEIR LEARNING THAT WILL BE MET WITH POSITIVE AND NEGATIVE CONSEQUENCES FROM YOU
