Greetings, Walter Reed Families!

This is our school message for the week of June 3rd.

As we begin the last week of the school year, please check for any school items at home that need to be returned to the classroom, the library, or the textbook room. Students have been returning their textbooks and need to clean out their lockers of all school and personal belongings. Please remember that any unpaid dues, such as library and cafeteria, will follow students to the next school year. 8th graders will not receive their Certificate of Completion until their dues are paid.

Please mark your calendars for next year's school registration on Wednesday, August 14th for 6th grade; Thursday, August 15th for 7th grade; and Friday, August 16th for 8th grade. Students will get their books, ID, and lockers on these days prior to school starting on Tuesday, August 20th. More information will be in a letter mailed home in early August.

The challenge was sponsored by our National Junior Honors Society students and a total amount nearly \$500.00 was raised! - Friday is for 6th and 7th grade.

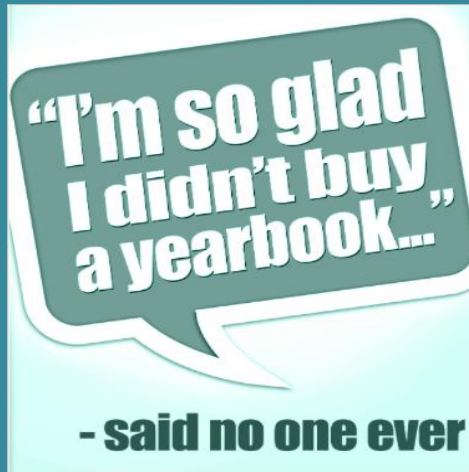
